

Study about experiences of care in women aged over 40 living with HIV

Now you can participate in a European research project that investigates how women (40+ years of age) living with HIV experience HIV care and the collaboration between different care providers in cases of co-morbidity.

Who can participate?

HIV-positive women who are 40 years of age or older.

How does it work?

You participate by completing an online survey. It takes approximately 15 minutes to complete, and all responses are completely anonymous. The survey is conducted throughout Europe and is available in a number of European languages, including Swedish and English. You can answer the survey between 1 June and 1 December 2023.
